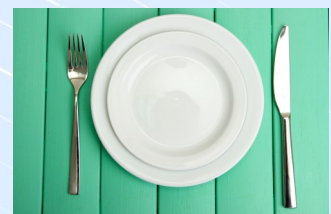
You may have seen on Class Dojo—the leaflet with the range of events happening in Tameside over the Easter holidays. It looks like there's a great variety of things happening across the borough.
