This week, our whole school attendance was 94.8%

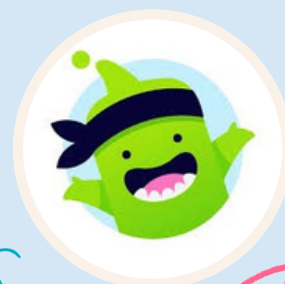
The winning class this week is Year 2 with 96.7% attendance.
